### Case Studies:

- 1) KHW started attending Just Learn from October 2021. He was new to the country and English is not his first language. KHW completed his GCSEs in Summer 2022 achieving a grade 9 in Mathematics and Physics as well as a grade 6 in Business Studies. KHW is currently studying A Levels at a 6<sup>th</sup> Form.
- 2) KB started attending Just Learn from June 2021. KB was referred to Just Learn due to persisting negative behaviour at her mainstream setting. KBs attendance to school improved from 58% to 82% over a 3 month period. KB completed her GCSEs in Summer 2022 achieving a grade 4 in English and Religious Studies. KB is currently studying the course of her choice at a college.
