Provider Access Policy

In accordance with the requirements of the Statutory Guidance, 'Careers guidance and access for education and training providers' (October 2018) and the obligations placed upon schools by Section 42B of the Education Act 1997, this policy statement sets out Just Learn's arrangements for managing the access of education and training providers to pupils at the school.

Pupil Entitlement

All pupils in years 7-11 are entitled to:

- planned careers provision which provides information about the full range of education and training options, including technical and apprenticeship routes, at each transition point.
- information from a wide range of education and training providers about the opportunities they offer– through options events, assemblies and aspirations events.
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.
